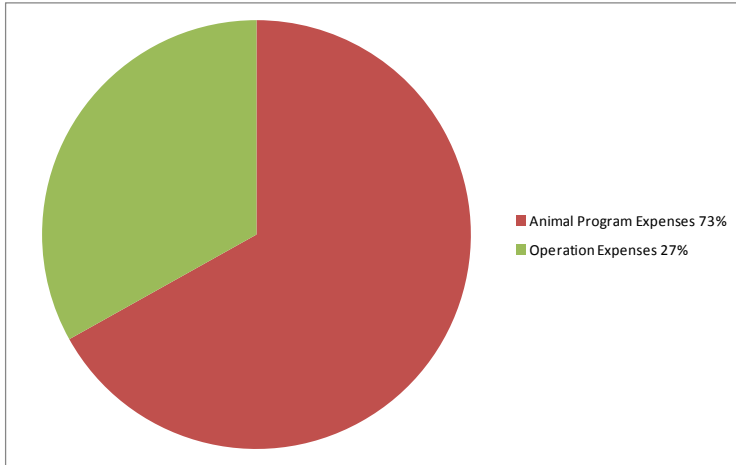
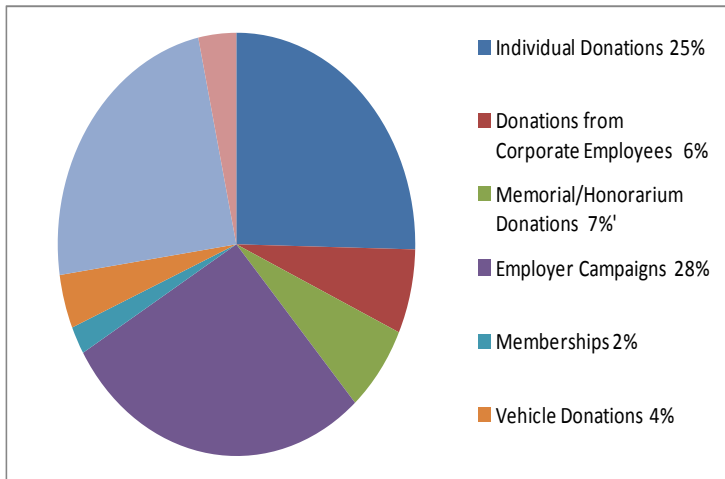




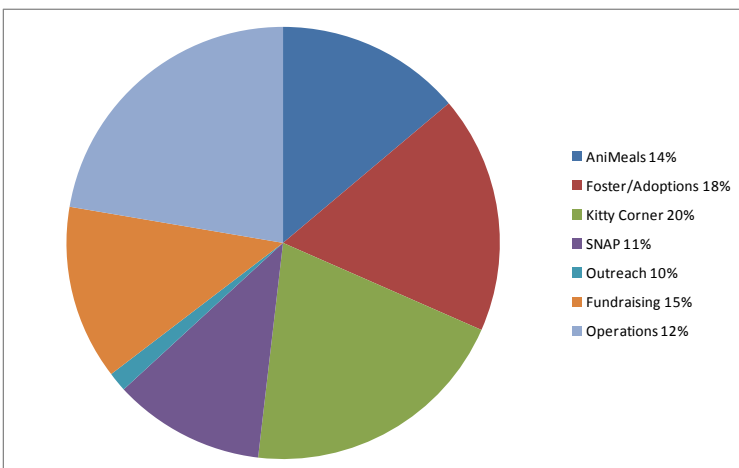
### OVERALL BREAKDOWN OF EXPENSES

### CCHS rescued

**154 animals and found forever homes for 197 this year!**

- \* 64 from Kitty Corner
- \* 70 (48 dogs, 22 cats) in Foster Care
- \* 63 animals by Operation Rescue Paws



**AniMeals provided pet food and supplies to on average 374 families each month feeding 226 dogs and 148 cats. In total 13,732 pounds were distributed.**



**CCHS authorized 360 spay/neuter procedures through the SNAP Program.**



**CCHS volunteers donated 6,954 hours to the animals and our programs!**
