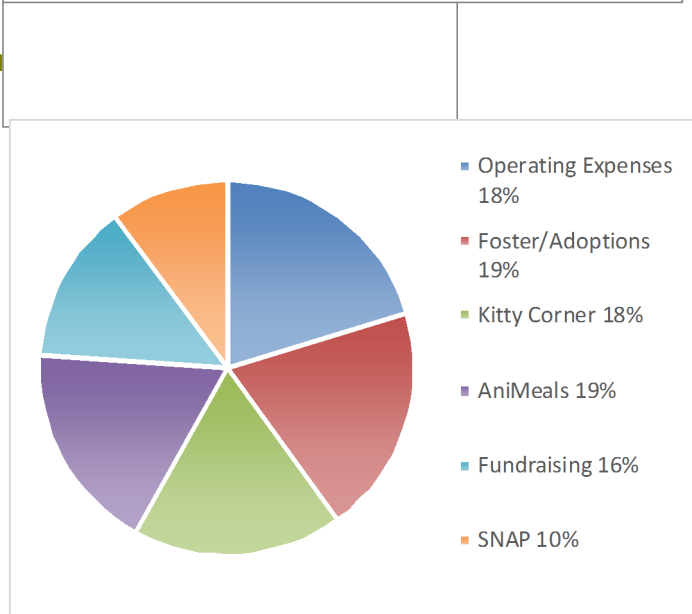
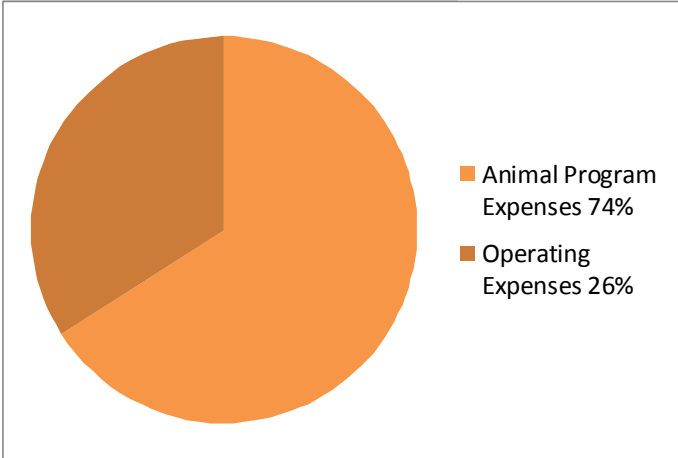
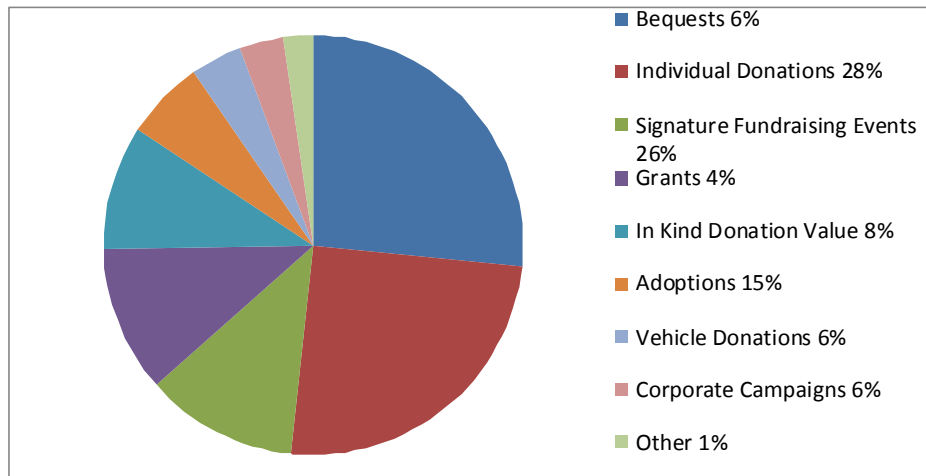




OVERALL BREAKDOWN OF EXPENSES

VISION STATEMENT:

PROGRAMS:

SAVING LIVES

Contra Costa Humane Society rescued or assisted 367 animals and found forever homes for 377 this year.

- 268 from Kitty Corner
- 95 (82 dogs, 13 cats) in foster care
- 6 animals by transfer partnerships
- 8 re-homed through our program
- 46 remain in CCHS care to find forever love

ANIMEALS

CCHS' supplemental pet food and supplies program served approximately 150 dogs and 154 cats monthly and on average 260 families with more than 21,000 pounds of food and 4,400 pounds

SPAY/NEUTER ASSISTANCE

CCHS authorized 298 spay/neuter procedures to residents of Contra Costa County.
